
FILM STORY DEVELOPMENT

This is a story based on my script. I'm in the process of storyboarding it, creating Character Art and Story Beat Concept pieces to pitch it.




ES - A colonist ship approaches a small planet (All conversations between the Captain o/s on the ship and the Major on land happen via radio)

APPROCHING MANOVRE"




ES - Parachute leaving the ship and landing **FX** - Hard impact sound. Dust rises.

MAJOR, CAN YOU STILL HEAR US?




Camera Zooms In and follows from above - Ship get close enough so the Major can parachutes down

CAN DETECT SIGNS OF LIFE"




FS on the Major - **FX** - The dust clears

Up Shot - Major descending towards the planet surface


Captain "GOOD LUCK, MAJOR! OUR FUTURE DEPENDS ON THIS MISSION SUCCESS"


WS - the lonely astronaut wanders on the planet. After a moment ...

"ANY SIGN OF LIFE YET, MAJOR?"




CUT - the Major analyzing the terrain

"BUT WE DETECT PLANT AND ANIMAL LIFE!"




Camera follows the Major's head standing up to a MS

THOUGH, CAPTAIN"




WS from high angle - the Major activates thrusters to move faster through the empty land

KEEP LOOKING!"




Major accelerates. Camera follows.

TO REACH ANOTHER PLANET..."




Major stops a moment . **ECU** on her face. We finally see her face behind the helmet's reflection.

Major "I'M APPROACHING TWO DUNES. I'LL GO INSPECT ONE" Captain "OK, WE'RE BEHIND YOU"




Zoom In on the cave entrance and to the Major

" SOMETHING GRASS-LIKE GROWS INSIDE!" Captain


"I KNEW IT! NOW RETREAT THOUGH ..."



Major's POV of the back of the dune


Major




WS- The Major approaching the cave

"I'LL GO TAKE A CLOSER LOOK!" Captain


" OK BUT PROCEED WITH CAUTION "



Location - Colonist ship's Isolation pod Time - 3am
